

ORDINANCE 1028

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE IDAHO, AMENDING SECTION 13.08.070 D. OF THE PAYETTE MUNICIPAL CODE BY INCREASING FEES FOR PUMPING CESSPOOL OR SEPTIC TANK WASTE; SETTING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; REPEALER; SEVERABILITY:

Be it Ordained by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Payette, Idaho:

Section 1. Section 13.08.070 D. of the Payette Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

13.08.070 D. A fee of one two dollars (\$2.00) per each one hundred gallons, with a minimum of five ten dollars (\$10.00) per each load, for emptying septic tank or cesspool pumping at the sewage treatment plant shall be charged. First time dumpers shall be charged a one time security deposit in the amount of \$50.00 to be paid to the City Clerk prior to receiving any dumping or pumping privileges. The Clerk shall issue a receipt for said deposit, and that receipt shall be presented to the waste water treatment plant superintendent prior to dumping. The deposit shall be returned after 9 months of prompt payment. If any payment is more than 10 days late, or remains unpaid for more than 10 days after being billed or if the City clerk is required to take any collection action, the deposit may be forfeited to pay any unpaid or delinquent pumping charges. If such action is required, no further pumping or dumping shall be allowed until a new \$50.00 deposit is provided to the City Clerk.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect after it's passage and publication as provided by law.

Section 3. All ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed insofar as the conflict exists.

Section 4. If any portion of this Ordinance is found to be unenforceable or unconstitutional for any reason, the remainder of the Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect and shall constitute Ordinance 1028.
