ORDINANCE NUMBER 1196

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, ADDING A NEW CHAPTER 13 IN TITLE 3 OF THE PAYETTE CITY CODE WHICH CHAPTER ALLOWS THE CITY IN A CALL FOR BIDS TO INCLUDE A REQUEST FOR REFERENCES FOR PREVIOUS EXPERIENCES WHICH REFLECT WORK OR SERVICE OR PRODUCT EXPERIENCE SIMILAR TO THOSE BEING REQUESTED IN THE PRESENT BID; ALLOWING A REJECTION OF ANY BID IN THE EVENT THE REFERENCES ARE NOT PROVIDED, SHOW A LACK OF EXPERTISE OR EXPERIENCE IN THE MATTERS BEING BID; SETTING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; ESTABLISHING SEVERABILITY; ESTABLISHING A REPEALER; ESTABLISHING A PENALTY;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO;

Section 1. There is hereby created a new chapter 13 in title 3 which is composed of Section 3.13.010 of the Payette City Code which section shall read as follows:

Chapter 3.13

Sections:

3.13.010 Bid Requirements

3.13.010 Bid Requirements; In any bid proposal let by the City, there may be included therein the following statement. "As a part of the bid specifications, you are required to submit a list of all similar sales, installations, materials or jobs of equivalent magnitude, which you have performed or provided in the past five (5) years. In addition to considering all other bid items, your bid will be evaluated in light of past experience. Past experience will be used to aid the City in determining the qualifications of "lowest responsible bidder" as that phrase is used in section 50-342 of the Idaho Code.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon passage and publication as required by law.

Section 3. Any ordinances or resolutions which are in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed, but only insofar as the conflict exists.

Section 4. If any portion of this Ordinance should be found to be unconstitutional or unenforceable for any reason, the remainder of the Ordinance shall constitute Ordinance Number 1196.
