

ORDINANCE NUMBER 1245

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, REPEALING CHAPTERS 2.08, 2.12, 2.16, 2.20, 2.24, 2.28, 2.32, 2.34, 2.36, 2.40, 2.44 OF THE PAYETTE CITY CODE; AMENDING SECTION 2.22.010; ENACTING A NEW CHAPTER 2.08 WHICH CHAPTER CREATES NEW SECTIONS 2.08.010, 2.08.020, 2.08.030 WHICH CODE SECTIONS PROVIDE FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF CITY OFFICIALS AS REQUIRED BY THE IDAHO CODE; ALLOWING THE MAYOR TO APPOINT WITH THE CONSENT OF THE COUNCIL OR HIRE SUCH OTHER PERSONS AS THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL MAY DEEM NECESSARY FOR THE EFFICIENT OPERATION OF THE CITY; PROVIDING THAT THE JOB DESCRIPTIONS MAY BE SET OUT IN AN EMPLOYEE MANUAL; SETTING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; ESTABLISHING SEVERABILITY; ESTABLISHING A REPEALER; ALLOWING PUBLICATION BY SUMMARY;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO;

Section 1. Chapters 2.08, 2.12, 2.16, 2.20, 2.24, 2.28, 2.32, 2.34, 2.36, 2.40, 2.44 in Title 2 of the PAYETTE CITY CODE are hereby repealed in full.

Section 2. There is hereby created a new chapter 2.08 in Title 2 of the Payette City Code which consists of sections 2.08.010, 2.08.020 and 2.08.030, which sections shall read as follows:

Chapter 2.08 Appointed Officials And Employees

2.08.010 Appointed Officials:

2.08.020 Other City Officials:

2.08.030 City Employees:

2.08.010 Appointed Officials: Pursuant to section 5-204 of the Idaho Code, the Mayor, with the consent of the council, shall appoint a city clerk, a city treasurer and a city attorney. Their duties shall be as defined by sections 50-207, 50-208 and 5-208A of the Idaho Code. Other duties may be set out in an employee manual or an employee handbook or such other document as may be adopted by the city.

2.08.020 Other City Officials: Notwithstanding the specific appointments as set out in section 2.08.010, the mayor, with the consent of the council, may appoint such other officials as the city may deem necessary or appropriate for the efficient operation of the city. Their duties may be set out in an employee manual or an employee handbook or such other document as may be adopted by the city.

2.08.030 City Employees: The city may hire such employees as the city may deem necessary or appropriate for the

efficient operation of the city. Their duties may be set out in an employee manual or an employee handbook or such other document as may be adopted by the city.

Section 3: Section 2.22.010 is hereby amended to read as follows.

2.22.010 Office Created: There is hereby created the office of Director of Public Safety. ~~Such office shall be filled by appointment by the Mayor, subject to confirmation by the City Council. The Director of Public Safety shall serve at the pleasure of the Mayor and City Council.~~

Section 4. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon passage and publication as required by law.

Section 5. Any ordinances or resolutions which are in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed, but only insofar as the conflict exists.

Section 6. If any portion of this Ordinance should be found be unconstitutional or unenforceable for any reason, the remainder of the Ordinance shall constitute Ordinance Number 1245.

Section 7. This Ordinance may be published in summary form.
