

ORDINANCE 1372

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, REPEALING SECTIONS 2.56.010, 2.56.020, 2.56.030, 2.56.040, 2.56.050, 2.56.060 IN CHAPTER 2.56 OF TITLE 2; SETTING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; ALLOWING PUBLICATION IN SUMMARY FORM; ESTABLISHING SEVERABILITY; ESTABLISHING A REPEALER.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF PAYETTE, IDAHO:

Section 1. Section 2.56.010, 2.56.020, 2.56.030, 2.56.040, 2.56.050, 2.56.060 of Title 2, Chapter 2.56 of the Payette Municipal Code is hereby repealed as follows:

~~There is created and established a commission, to be known as the "Payette traffic commission", for the city. (Prior code § 2-3-1)~~

~~2.56.020: TERMS OF OFFICE; COMPOSITION:~~

~~A. The traffic safety commission shall consist of four (4) members to be appointed by the mayor, with the consent and approval of the council. Members of said commission shall hold office for a term of six (6) years each.~~

~~B. Members shall be selected so that there shall always remain in the commission one public works director, one councilman, one chief of police, and one city attorney and members shall serve without compensation. (Prior code § 2-3-2)~~

~~2.56.030: VACANCY FILLING:~~

~~Vacancies shall be filled by appointment of the mayor, with the consent of the council. (Prior code § 2-3-3)~~

~~2.56.040: ORGANIZATION:~~

~~The commission shall elect its own chairman and secretary, shall create and fill such other offices as it may determine necessary and shall adopt such rules as it deems necessary to carry out its purpose. (Prior code § 2-3-4)~~

~~2.56.050: MEETINGS:~~

~~The commission shall hold one regular meeting each month for not less than nine (9) months in each year. A majority of the appointive members of the commission shall be necessary to~~

~~constitute a quorum at any meeting. All meetings shall be open to the public. A written record of its meetings, resolutions, findings and determinations shall be kept, which shall be public record.~~

~~The commission may require the attendance at any meeting of such other city officials as it may deem necessary. (Prior code § 2-3-5)~~

**2.56.060: DUTIES:**

~~It shall be the duty of the commission to recommend and make suggestions to the council for the adoption of plans for traffic safety as recommended by the national safety council study of 1968; to coordinate all city traffic safety plans into the state plan; to make suggestions for projects designed to increase safety in pedestrian and school traffic in the city; and to generally recommend to the council plans to improve traffic safety in the entire city. (Prior code § 2-3-6)~~

Section 2. This Ordinance may be published in summary form allowed by Idaho Code

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon passage and publication as required by the laws of the State of Idaho.

Section 4. Any ordinances or resolutions which are in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed, but only insofar as the conflict exists.

Section 5. If any portion of this Ordinance should be found to be unconstitutional or unenforceable for any reason, the remainder of the Ordinance shall be applied to effectuate the purposes of this Ordinance.

SUMMARY OF ORDINANCE 1372

Ordinance 1372 is an ordinance of the City Of Payette, Idaho, adopted January 7, 2013. The ordinance may be descriptively known as the ordinance that repeals the Traffic Safety Commission code. Ordinance 1372 repeals Chapter 2.56 of Title 2 the Payette Municipal Code in its entirety. The ordinance sets an effective date, allows publication in summary form, establishes severability and establishes a repealer.
