

ORDINANCE NO.1471

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE STATE OF IDAHO; PROVIDING FOR THE AMENDMENT OF PAYETTE CITY CODE, TITLE 10, CHAPTER 10.20, BY UPDATING THE TIME AND PLACES PARKING IS ALLOWED WITHIN THE CITY AND REPEALING THE REQUIREMENT FOR LICENSED CONTRACTORS TO PROVIDE SNOW REMOVAL; PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR VIOLATIONS; AND PROVIDING SEVERABILITY, CODIFICATION, PUBLICATION BY SUMMARY, AND ESTABLISHING EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PAYETTE CITY COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Title 10, Chapter 10.20 PARKING, Sections 10.20.010 and 10.20.020 of the Payette Municipal Code are hereby repealed as follows:

~~10.20.010: ALL NIGHT; PROHIBITED IN BUSINESS DISTRICT WHEN:~~

~~It is unlawful for any person except physicians on emergency calls, to park a vehicle within the business district for a period of time longer than thirty (30) minutes between two o'clock (2:00) A.M. and seven o'clock (7:00) A.M. of any day.~~

~~10.20.020: TRUCKS IN BUSINESS DISTRICT; PROHIBITED:~~

~~Parking of trucks and/or truck trailers is prohibited within the business district.~~

Section 2. Title 10, Chapter 10.20 PARKING, Section 10.20.090 of the Payette Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

10.20.090: TIME RESTRICTION IN CERTAIN AREAS; DESIGNATED NO PARKING AREAS; PENALTY FOR VIOLATION:

- A. It is the purpose of this section to alleviate traffic congestion and to alleviate parking congestion caused by numerous operators of motor vehicles who park their vehicles for unreasonably long periods of time in the most congested streets of the city and thus impede traffic.
- B. It is unlawful to park any motor vehicle for more than two (2) hours continuously at any one place between eight o'clock (8:00) A.M. and six o'clock (6:00) P.M., on any day except on Sundays and legal holidays, upon 1st Avenue North between the alley one-half ($\frac{1}{2}$) block west of 8th Street and the alley one-half ($\frac{1}{2}$) block east of 8th Street, Center Avenue between 7th Street and 9th Street, 1st Avenue South between 8th Street and the alley one-half ($\frac{1}{2}$) block east of 8th Street, and 8th Street between 3rd Avenue North and 2nd Avenue South.

- C. Any person convicted of a violation of this section shall be fined a fee set by resolution. ~~Upon a third or subsequent conviction of a violation of said section, within any ninety (90) day period, the fine shall be set by resolution.~~
- D. It is unlawful for the operator of any motor vehicle to move such motor vehicle within the area designated in subsection B of this section for the purpose of evading the time limit prescribed therein.
- E. There shall be no parking in the traveled or paved portion of the highway right of way on 16th Street, commonly known as Highway 95, from three hundred feet (300') north of 7th Avenue North to three hundred feet (300') south of 6th Avenue South. Parking in violation of this subsection shall be an infraction.
- F. There shall be no parking on, over or along South 18th Street, commonly known as Highway 52, from one hundred fifty feet (150') north or south of the intersection of South 18th Street and Hughes Drive. Parking in violation of this subsection shall be an infraction.
- G. No person shall stop or park a vehicle, except when necessary to avoid conflict with other traffic or in compliance with law or the directions of a police officer or traffic control device, in any of the following places:
1. On a bike lane or bike path.
 2. Adjacent to any yellow painted curb or fire lane.
 3. In front of a free-standing mailbox or blocking the same from postal vehicle access.

Section 3. Title 10, Chapter 10.20 PARKING, Section 10.20.190 of the Payette Municipal Code is hereby amended as follows:

10.20.190: REMOVAL OF VEHICLE AT OWNER'S EXPENSE:

~~From February 16 to November 14, a~~Any vehicle which is parked in violation of any parking restrictions stated herein, after the violation is allowed to exist for a period of twenty-four (24) hours, shall be subject to immediate removal at the owner's expense. This shall not, in any way, change, amend or alter the right of removal as defined in specific sections hereinabove set forth.

Section 4. Title 10, Chapter 10.20 PARKING, Sections 10.20.070, 10.20.220 and 10.20.230 of the Payette Municipal Code are hereby repealed as follows:

~~10.20.170: WEIGHT LIMITATION:~~

~~No truck or van of more than one ton capacity shall be parked upon any street in the city.~~

~~10.20.220: SNOW REMOVAL; PRIVATE CONTRACTOR:~~

~~Snow removed from private property by someone other than the property owner, renter or lessee shall be done by a private contractor who is licensed by the city.~~

~~10.20.230: CONTRACTOR DEFINED:~~

~~"Contractor" shall be defined as someone who is paid to remove or plow snow with a motorized piece of equipment.~~

Section 5. This Ordinance may be published in summary form allowed by Idaho Code.

Section 6. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon passage and publication as required by the laws of the State of Idaho.

Section 7. Any ordinances or resolutions which are in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed, but only insofar as the conflict exists.

Section 8. If any portion of this Ordinance should be found to be unconstitutional or unenforceable for any reason, the remainder of the Ordinance shall be applied to effectuate the purposes of this Ordinance.


Section 9. Any violation of this ordinance shall be a infraction.
