

ORDINANCE NO. 1505

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE STATE OF IDAHO; PROVIDING FOR THE AMENDMENT OF PAYETTE CITY CODE, TITLE 6 ANIMALS, CHAPTER 6.08 DOGS, SECTION 6.08.020 LICENSE REQUIREMENTS, BY ADDING THE EXISTING REQUIREMENT OF NO MORE THAN THREE DOGS TO NEW SECTION; PROVIDING SEVERABILITY, CODIFICATION, PUBLICATION BY SUMMARY, AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PAYETTE CITY COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Title 6 Animals, Chapter 6.08 Dogs, Section 6.08.020 License Requirements, of the Payette Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

**6.08.020: LICENSE REQUIREMENTS:**

It shall be unlawful to keep, maintain, harbor or possess upon any one premises more than three (3) dogs except as provided below or as provided in section 6.08.040 of this chapter.

A. License Required:

1. Any person who shall own or keep any dog within the City limits shall first obtain a license therefor in compliance with this chapter;

a. Provided, however, that the provisions of this section shall not apply to any person visiting in the City for a period not exceeding thirty (30) days, any nonresident of the City not maintaining a dog within the City limits, or the owner of any dog under four (4) months of age.

2. It shall be unlawful for any person to own or keep a vicious dog within the City limits prior to the issuance of a City of Payette dog license. No license shall be issued to the owner of any vicious dog prior to complete compliance with all sections of this chapter. Compliance with this chapter shall be verified by the Chief of Police, or his designee.

Section 2. This Ordinance may be published in summary form allowed by Idaho Code.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon passage and publication as required by the laws of the State of Idaho.


Section 4. Any ordinances or resolutions which are in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed, but only insofar as the conflict exists.

Section 5. If any portion of this Ordinance should be found to be unconstitutional or unenforceable for any reason, the remainder of the Ordinance shall be applied to effectuate the purposes of this Ordinance.
