

ORDINANCE NO 1528

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE STATE OF IDAHO; PROVIDING FOR THE AMENDMENT OF PAYETTE CITY CODE, TITLE 9 PUBLIC PEACE, MORALS & WELFARE BY REPEALING, CHAPTER 9.18.010, INTOXICATED PERSONS, AND PROVIDING SEVERABILITY, CODIFICATION, PUBLICATION BY SUMMARY, AND ESTABLISHING EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PAYETTE CITY COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Chapter 9.56.010 INTOXICATED PERSONS of Title 9, PUBLIC PEACE, MORALS & WELFARE of the Payette Municipal Code is hereby repealed as follows:

9.18.010: ACTS CONSTITUTING MISDEMEANOR:

~~—A.— Any person who is in a state of intoxication within the city limits shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor.~~

~~—B.— Any person who is in a state of intoxication and is violent, riotous, disorderly and uses obscene or indecent language, in or upon any street or alley or in or about any public premises or place of general or public resort within the city limits, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor.~~

Section 2. This Ordinance may be published in summary form allowed by Idaho Code.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon passage and publication as required by the laws of the State of Idaho.

Section 4. Any ordinances or resolutions which are in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed, but only insofar as the conflict exists.

Section 5. If any portion of this Ordinance should be found to be unconstitutional or unenforceable for any reason, the remainder of the Ordinance shall be applied to effectuate the purposes of this Ordinance.
