

ORDINANCE 1571

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, AMENDING THE PAYETTE MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 12.05.070: BONDING REQUIRED OF TITLE 12 STREETS, SIDEWALKS AND PARKS IN CHAPTER 12.05 ENCROACHMENT PERMITS, TO INCREASE MINIMUM BOND REQUIREMENTS; SETTING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; ALLOWING PUBLICATION IN SUMMARY FORM; ESTABLISHING SEVERABILITY; ESTABLISHING A REPEALER.

WHEREAS, the City of Payette seeks to protect public infrastructure and ensure proper completion of work performed within the public right-of-way; and

WHEREAS, the current bond requirements for encroachment permits are no longer sufficient to cover the costs associated with potential damage, incomplete work, or non-compliance; and

WHEREAS, increasing the required bond amounts will better protect the public interest and ensure compliance with applicable standards and specifications;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Payette does ordain as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 12.05.070 Bonding Required in Section 12.05 Encroachment Permits of Title 12 Streets, Sidewalks and Parks, of the Payette Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

12.05.070: BONDING REQUIRED:

All commercial enterprises, including but not limited to paving companies, general contractors, subcontractors and landscapers, submitting an application or performing work under the provisions of this chapter shall also provide or have on file with the city clerk a current bond in the minimum amount of twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000). The minimum amount of the bond required in this section may be adjusted by the city engineer, depending upon the size and nature of the project. In lieu of a bond, cash may be substituted for a bond.

Section 2. This Ordinance may be published in summary form allowed by Idaho Code.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon passage and publication as required by the laws of the State of Idaho.

Section 4. Any ordinances or resolutions which are in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed, but only insofar as the conflict exists.

Section 5. If any portion of this Ordinance should be found to be unconstitutional or unenforceable for any reason, the remainder of the Ordinance shall be applied to effectuate the purposes of this Ordinance.


