

RESOLUTION 2022-05

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE STATE OF IDAHO; PROVIDING THAT DEANNEXATION OF PROPERTY FROM THE CITY OF PAYETTE IS NOT PERMITTED, NO APPLICATION FOR DEANNEXATION IS CONSIDERED VALID AND THAT NO APPLICATION FOR DEANNEXATION WILL BE ACCEPTED OR CONSIDERED UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Idaho Code §50-222 provides that a city may annex property to expand its corporate boundaries and that Idaho Code §50-225 provides that a city may exclude land from its corporate boundaries through the exercise of its discretion; and

WHEREAS, the City of Payette has adopted an annexation ordinance and a process for annexation of property into the city consistent with the adoption of its comprehensive plan but has not adopted a deannexation ordinance for exclusion of property from the city; and


WHEREAS, annexation of property is based upon the thoughtful and considered expansion of city boundaries while deannexation would be accomplished on an ad hoc basis without regard to the comprehensive plan and orderly development of the city.

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion duly made, seconded, and carried, it is hereby declared and resolved that deannexation of property from the corporate boundaries of the city is not consistent with the orderly development of the city, is not permitted and therefore no application for deannexation shall be accepted or considered by the City of Payette until further notice and by the adoption of an ordinance that allows for the process of deannexation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that any application for deannexation submitted prior to the date of this resolution and unresolved is hereby rejected and shall not be processed, but returned to the party requesting deannexation.

This Resolution was adopted by the Council of the City of Payette and shall become effective as of the date of its passage.
