**A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF THE
CHILD PEDESTRIAN SAFETY PROGRAM
GRANT APPLICATION**

WHEREAS, The Local Highway Technical Assistance Council (LHTAC) is offering a Children Pedestrian Safety Program grant opportunity with a maximum grant award in the amount of \$250,000 with no match required for projects related to maintenance, and address safety and mobility; and,

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Payette, Idaho desires to create a safer environment for children to walk to school and other places in the community, and to help increase the safety and health of all its citizens by providing a pathway system to take pedestrians off the roadways of the City; and,


WHEREAS, the City desires to pursue a grant in order to fund the infill of sidewalks and American Disabilities Act (ADA) corner ramps and crossings along 3rd Avenue North in front of the Primary School and Courthouse, and along North 12th Street, North 11th Street and 1st Avenue North around the Courthouse adjacent to the Primary School, and an enhanced crosswalk signal at the intersection of State Highway 52 and 7th Avenue North; and,

WHEREAS, the installation of sidewalks, ADA corner ramps, and safe pedestrian crossings will increase the safety and mobility of multimodal transportation in the City of Payette.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Payette, Payette County, Idaho, that the City Council supports this project and hereby directs City staff to apply for this grant, with the understanding that there is no local match required.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the Mayor or the City Treasurer is hereby authorized to sign any and all documents necessary to apply for this funding.
