

**CITY OF PAYETTE
RESOLUTION NO. 2023-02**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, PROVIDING THAT INSOFAR AS NO RESPONSIVE BIDS WERE RECEIVED IN RESPONSE TO THE DULY AUTHORIZED INVITATION TO BID NOTICE FOR THE NEW WATER WELL PROJECT, THE MAYOR OR HIS DESIGNEE IS AUTHORIZED TO NEGOTIATE WITH A PUBLIC WORKS CONTRACTOR WITHOUT FURTHER COMPETITIVE BIDDING PROCEDURES PURSUANT TO IDAHO CODE § 67-2805(2)(a)(viii); PROVIDING THIS RESOLUTION TO BE EFFECTIVE UPON ITS PASSAGE AND APPROVAL.

WHEREAS, pursuant to I.C. § 67-2805(2)(a) the City of Payette duly adhered to the competitive sealed bid process for the procurement of public works construction valued in excess of two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) having duly published Legal Notice – Invitation to Bid soliciting sealed bids from licensed public works contractors for the New Well Project (Well #24) consisting of the drilling of a new municipal drinking water well contained within the limits of the City of Payette boundaries; and

WHEREAS, at the public bid opening on December 15, 2022, no responsive bids were received; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to I.C. § 67-2805(2)(a)(viii) the City of Payette may:

[i]n its discretion ... after finding it to be a fact, pass a resolution declaring that the project sought to be accomplished by the expenditure can be performed more economically by purchasing goods and services on the open market. ... If no bids are received, the governing board may procure the goods or services without further competitive bidding procedures.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Payette as follows:

Section 1: Upon finding that the City of Payette has adhered to the competitive sealed bid process for the procurement of public works construction pursuant to I.C. § 67-2805(2)(a) and upon finding that no bids were received, the City of Payette declares that the procurement of public works services for the construction of the New Water Well Project can be performed more economically by purchasing goods and services on the open market.


Section 2: The Mayor or his designee are authorized to undertake negotiations to procure the goods or services without further competitive bidding procedures.

Section 3: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval.
