

**CITY OF PAYETTE
RESOLUTION NO. 2024-01**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, PROVIDING THAT INSOFAR AS NO RESPONSIVE BIDS WERE RECEIVED IN RESPONSE TO THE DULY AUTHORIZED INVITATION TO BID NOTICE FOR THE ALLEY SEWER PROJECT, THE MAYOR OR HIS DESIGNEE IS AUTHORIZED TO NEGOTIATE WITH A PUBLIC WORKS CONTRACTOR WITHOUT FURTHER COMPETITIVE BIDDING PROCEDURES PURSUANT TO IDAHO CODE § 67-2805(1)(e); PROVIDING THE RESOLUTION SHALL BE EFFECTIVE UPON ITS PASSAGE AND APPROVAL.

WHEREAS, pursuant to I.C. § 67-2805(1)(a) the City of Payette duly adhered to the competitive sealed bid process for the procurement of public works construction valued between fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) and two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) where five licensed public works contractors were solicited in writing to present bids for the Alley Sewer Project contained within the limits of the City of Payette; and

WHEREAS, the request for bids was sent on January 4, 2024 and the bids were due at City Hall on January 23, 2024 by 10:00 a.m.; and

WHEREAS, no bids were received; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to I.C. § 67-2805(1)(e) the City of Payette may:

If the political subdivision finds that it is impractical or impossible to obtain three (3) bids for the proposed public works procurement, the political subdivision may acquire the work in any manner the political subdivision deems best from a qualified public works contractor quoting the lowest price....


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Payette as follows:

Section 1: Upon finding that the City of Payette has adhered to the competitive sealed bid process for the procurement of public works construction pursuant to I.C. § 67-2805(1)(a) and upon finding that no bids were received, the City of Payette declares that the procurement of public works services for the construction of the Alley Sewer Project can be performed more economically by purchasing goods and services on the open market.

Section 2: The Mayor or his designee are authorized to undertake negotiations to procure the goods or services without further competitive bidding procedures.


Section 3: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval.
