AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 32 OF ORDINANCE NO. 379 OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, PRESCRIBING NEW REGULATIONS FOR THE PARKING OF VEHICLES WITHIN THE CITY OF PAYETTE, AND REPEALING SUCH PARTS OF SAID ORDINANCE AS ARE INCONSISTANT HEREWITH.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Councilmen of the City of Payette, Idaho:

That Section 32 of Ordinance No. 379 as passed by the City Council of the City of Payette, Idaho, as approved by the Mayor of the City of Payette, Idaho, on the 19th day of August, 1929, be, and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 32.

1. No vehicle shall be parked within ten feet of any fire hydrant in the City of Payette, and no vehicle shall be parked in front of the fire station on the South side of Third Avenue North between Eighth Street and Ninth Street, between a point twenty-five feet West of the entrance of said fire station and a point twenty-five feet East of said entrance to said fire station.

No persons shall leave an automobile or other motor vehicle parked or unattended in an alley within the City of Payette.

No car or other vehicle shall be parked nearer than ten feet to any sidewalk crossing; except within designated marked lanes on Eighth Street, Center Avenue and First Avenue North, as hereinafter provided.

2. That no truck of more than one-half ton capacity shall be parked upon Eighth Street Between Third Avenue North and Second Avenue South, of said city, and/or on Center Avenue between Eighth Street and Ninth Street, and/or on First Avenue North be-

tween Seventh Street and Eighth Street of said city.

That no truck or vehicle with a trailer attached shall be parked upon Eighth Street between Third Avenue North and Second Avenue South, of said city, and/or on Center Avenue between Eighth Street and Ninth Street, and/or on First Avenue North between Seventh Street and Eighth Street of said city.

SECTION 3. That no double parking shall be allowed on Eighth Street of said city between Third Avenue North and Second Avenue South, except that a passenger vehicle may be allowed to double park on said street within said limits for a period of not longer than five minutes, provided however, that at all times during said period, there is a duly licensed driver in said vehicle.

SECTION 4. All cars and motor vehicles parked on Eighth Street between Third Avenue North and Second Avenue South and/or on Center Avenue between Eighth Street and Ninth Street, and/or on First Avenue North between Seventh Street and Eighth Street of said city, shall be parked only between designated marked lanes, marked off by the city of Payette; that no such vehicle shall be parked so that any portion thereof shall protrude beyond either one, and/or both of the lines designating the lane within which said motor vehicle is parked.

5. That the fourth paragraph of said Section of said Ordinance No. 379 be, and the same is hereby repealed.
