

ORDINANCE NO. 426

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 415 PROVIDING FOR A CHANGE OF LICENSE FEE, AND ADDING A NEW SECTION DEFINING CERTAIN MACHINES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO:

Section 1. That Section 3 of Ordinance No. 415, as passed by the City Council of the City of Payette, Idaho, and approved by the Mayor of said city on the 3rd day of August, 1936, be, and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 3.- Every operator shall pay a license fee of \$30.00 per quarter year, or fraction thereof, for every such machine maintained at any place in Payette where the same may be played by the public. A change of machine shall be permissible under said license, that is, the licensee shall be permitted to maintain the number of machines designated in said license and may change such machines about, at no time maintaining a greater number of machines than covered by such license."

Section 2. That there be added to said ordinance, a new Section to be designated as Section 10, providing as follows:

"Section.- When a machine as herein defined has two or more trip levers so that two or more parts thereof can be played or operated independently, such machine shall be licensed as if each part of said machine were a separate machine, as herein defined, and the operator thereof shall be required to pay a license fee for each trip lever thereon.

This ordinance shall take effect on September 1, 1937, and after its passage, approval and publication.
