ORDINANCE NO. 451
BY WATER COMMITTEE.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 4 OF ORDINANCE NO. 301 AND SECTION 23 OF ORDINANCE NO. 301 OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, AS AMENDED BY ORDINANCE NO. 353, AND AS AMENDED BY ORDINANCE NO. 377, TO REGULATE THE CHARGE FOR CITY WATER, AND ADDING A NEW SECTION TO SAID ORDINANCE NO. 301 TO BE DESIGNATED AS SECTION 23-A PROVIDING FOR A METER DEPOSIT.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of Payette, Idaho:

Section 1- That section 4 of Ordinance No. 301 be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 4- That hereafter the service pipes must be so arranged that the supply of water for each separate house or premises shall be controlled by a separate stop cock, placed within or near the line of street curb and the water supply shall be measured by a meter, and the owner of the house or of the premises must pay for all water used through such meter connection or connections for his or their use or the use of others to whom it may be accessible."

Section 2- That Section 23 of Ordinance No. 301 as amended by Ordinance No. 353 and as amended by Ordinance No. 377, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 23- The monthly charges for city water shall be made and collected at the following rates, to-wit:

1. The minimum monthly charge for each meter service within the city limits shall be \$1.50, and outside the city limits shall be \$2.00. This minimum charge shall entitle the user to the delivery
