

ORDINANCE NO. 456

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING OFFICIAL BOND OF CERTAIN OFFICERS OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 9, PASSED AND APPROVED SEPTEMBER 9, 1905, ORDINANCE NO. 120 PASSED AND APPROVED JUNE 5, 1908 AND ORDINANCE NO. 270 PASSED AND APPROVED MAY 17, 1915.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Payette, Idaho:

SECTION 1 - The Clerk, Treasurer, Police Judge, Chief of Police and all Policemen and City Engineer before entering upon the duties of their offices shall file with the City Clerk good and sufficient Bonds with sufficient sureties, to be approved by the City Council for the faithful performance of the duties of their respective offices in the following amounts, to-wit:

1. The Clerk in the sum of \$10,000.00.
2. The Treasurer, in the sum of \$50,000.00.
3. The Police Judge in the sum of \$500.00.
4. The Chief-of-Police and all Policemen \$1000.00 each.
5. The City Engineer in the sum of \$2000.00.

SECTION 2 - That Ordinance No. 9, passed and approved September 9, 1905 and Ordinance No. 120, passed and approved June 5, 1908, and Ordinance No. 270, passed and approved May 17, 1915 be and they are hereby repealed.
