

ORDNANCE NO. 461

AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE DUTIES OF THE CITY ATTORNEY AND REPEALING SECTIONS 191, 192, 193, 194, 195 AND 196 OF THE GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, 1920; SECTIONS 1, 2, 3, 4, AND 5 OF ORDINANCE 118 AND SECTION 4 OF ORDINANCE 224 FIXING THE DUTIES AND SALARY OF THE CITY ATTORNEY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO:

Section 1. City Attorney -- Duties. The City Attorney shall be the legal adviser of the council. He shall commence, prosecute and defend all suits and actions necessary to be commenced prosecuted or defended on behalf of the corporation, or that may be ordered by the council. When requested, he shall attend meetings of the council, give them his opinion upon any matters submitted to him, either orally or in writing as may be required.

Section 2. Sections 1, 2, 3, 4, and 5 of Ordinance 118 and Section 4 of Ordinance 224 be and the same are hereby repealed.
