

ORDINANCE NO. 471

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 7 OF ORDINANCE 396, AS AMENDED BY ORDINANCE 400, AS AMENDED BY ORDINANCE 402 PROVIDING THAT IT SHALL BE UNLAWFUL FOR ANY RETAILER TO PERMIT ANY PERSON UNDER 20 YEARS OF AGE TO CONSUME ANY BEER ON HIS PREMISES, OR TO SELL, GIVE AWAY OR OTHERWISE DISPOSE OF ANY BEER TO ANY PERSON UNDER THE AGE OF 20 YEARS AND FIXING THE HOURS FOR RETAILERS OF BEER TO SELL OR PERMIT THE CONSUMPTION OF BEER ON HIS PREMISES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO:

Section 1. That Section 7 of Ordinance 396, as amended by Section 1 of Ordinance 400, as amended by Section 1 of Ordinance 402, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 7. It shall be unlawful for any retailer to suffer or permit any person under the age of 20 to consume any beer as defined in this ordinance, in or upon his premises, or for any retailer to sell, give away or in anywise dispose of any such beer to any person under the age of 20 years; or for any retailer to sell, give away or dispose of any such beer or to permit any such beer as defined in this ordinance to be consumed by any person in or upon his premises at any time between the hours of one o'clock, A.M. and six o'clock, A.M.
