

ORDINANCE NO. 472

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 245 OF THE GENERAL ORDINANCES CITY OF PAYETTE, 1920, BEING SECTION 4 OF ORDINANCE 144, FIXING THE LICENSE FEE AND TERM OF LICENSE FOR POOL TABLES, CARD TABLES, BILLIARD TABLES AND BOWLING ALLEYS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO:

Section 1. That Section 245 of the General Ordinances City of Payette, 1920, being Section 4 of Ordinance 144, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 245. License Fee. The License Fee shall be as follows: for each and every pool table, the sum of \$2.00 per quarter; for each and every card table, the sum of \$15.00 per quarter; for each and every billiard table, the sum of \$1.50 per quarter; for one bowling alley, the sum of \$2.50 per quarter; and for each additional alley, the sum of \$1.25 per quarter; provided, that no license shall be issued for a longer or shorter period than one quarter, except the unexpired term of the quarter in which the same are applied for; provided, further, that the license herein provided for shall not be construed to license or in any manner allow any gambling, but is only a tax to be paid when the games herein mentioned are run or operated as a means of recreation or pleasure.
