

ORDINANCE NO. 473

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING THAT THE CITY CLERK SHALL BE COLLECTOR OF WATER CHARGES AND PROVIDING THAT WATER SHALL BE SHUT OFF WHEN SUCH CHARGES ARE NOT PAID AND REPEALING SECTION 8 OF THE GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, 1920, BEING SECTION 2 OF ORDINANCE 237 WHICH PROVIDES THAT THE CITY MARSHALL SHALL BE THE CUSTODIAN OF THE CITY HALL.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO:

Section 1. The City Clerk shall be the collector of water charges for the city waterworks system, and when water users fail to pay water charges as provided by the Council, he shall forthwith notify the water superintendent whose duty it shall be to shut off the water in accordance with regulations of the Council.

Section 2. That Section 8 of the General Ordinances of the City of Payette, 1920, being Section 2 of Ordinance 237 be and the same is hereby repealed.
