ORDINANCE NO. 477

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 4 OF ORDINANCE 329 BY DIVIDING THE SAME INTO SEVENTEEN SECTIONS AND FIXING THE LICENSE FEES FOR VARIOUS KINDS OF AMUSEMENTS, BUSINESSES AND PROFESSIONS, AND REPEALING ORDINANCE 385 WHICH ORDINANCE PROVIDED FOR LICENSING MINATURE GOLF LINKS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO:

Section 1. That Section 4 of Ordinance 329 be and the same is hereby amended, by dividing the same into separate sections to be numbered sections 4A to 4P inclusive and, to read as follows:

Section 4. The fees for the various licenses provided for in this ordinance shall be fixed by Sections 4A to 4P inclusive.

Section 4A. (a) Circuses, Caravans and Menageries. Every circus, caravan or menagerie, if traveling on the highway or on the railroad and having less than twenty trucks or railroad cars, \$25.00 per day; if having twenty trucks or railroad cars or more, \$50.00 per day.

(b) Each dog and pony show, if traveling on highway or railroad with less than ten trucks or railroad cars, \$12.50 per day.

(c) For each Wild West show or other shows not herein enumerated, traveling on the highway or railroad and having twenty trucks or railroad cars or more, \$50.00 per day, if having less than twenty trucks or railroad cars, \$20.00 per day.

(d) Each side show, exhibition or separate performance, connected with a circus or show where a charge of admission is made in addition to the admission fee of the main circus or show, \$5.00 per day.

(e) All other shows charging an admission fee for exhibition, practicing or performing, jugglery, acrobatic feats, wire walking, sleight of hand performance, and all other shows and exhibitions not herein enumerated, \$5.00 per day.

Section 4B. All traveling or itinerant carnivals, or street shows, exhibiting partially in tents or temporary structures, or wholly in the open air, or wholly in tents or other temporary structures, shall pay a license fee of \$100.00 for each and every day so exhibiting and operating.

Section 4C. All entertainments of a theatrical, dramatic or operatic character, all lectures, readings or recitations, exhibitions of paintings, statutory or other exhibitions of art; All musical entertainments, consisting solely of vocal or instrumental music or both; all entertainments commonly styled and known as

concerts, shall pay a license fee of \$2.00 for the first day and \$1.00 for each successive day thereafter.

Section 4D. All Traveling or itinerant moving picture shows shall pay a license fee of \$5.00 per day.

Section 4E. All merry-go-rounds, revolving wheels and mechanical rides of a similar nature shall pay a license fee of \$5.00 per day.

Section 4F. All skating rinks, slides and similar places of amusements shall pay a license fee of \$10.00 per quarter.

Section 4G. All small itinerant shows such as bird shows, galvanic batteries, swings, lifting machines, blowing and striking machines, shooting galleries, cane racks, and similar devices or amusements shall pay a license fee of \$5.00 per day.

Section 4H. All wrestling or boxing exhibitions for which an admission fee is charged, shall pay a license fee of \$3.00 per day.

Section 4I. All public dances or other entertainments of a like nature, when an admission fee is charged or a fee collected for dancing or participating in the entertainment or amusements, shall pay a license fee of \$2.50 per day.

Section 4J. All other exhibitions, performances, entertainments or amusement devices not included in Sections 4A to 4I, shall pay a license fee of \$5.00 per day.

Section 4K. Each and every person who shall offer any article for sale from a stand, wagon or other vehicle, upon any street, public or open ground within the limits of the City of Payette, shall pay a license fee of \$25.00 per day.

Section 4L. Each and every traveling photographer, who as principal or agent, shall engage in a temporary or transient business, taking, vending, or in any manner offering for sale photographs, views or enlargements, for pay, or who shall, either for himself or agent for another by means of coupons, tickets, or part payments solicit business in the City of Payette, pertaining to photography, copying or enlarging pictures, shall pay a license fee of \$10.00 for the first day and \$5.00 for each and every day thereafter while so engaged.

Section 4M. Every auctioneer shall pay a license fee of \$3.00 per quarter. Provided, that nothing in this ordinance shall require a public officer in the discharge of his duty to pay a license for any sale of property sold under provisions of the law.

Section 4N. Each and every traveling oculist or optician who as a principal or agent shall engage in a temporary or transient business or in the occasional pursuit of his profession in the City of Payette, shall pay a license fee of \$25.00 for each and every day so engaged.

Section 4O. Clairvoyants, palmists, astrologers, seers or fortune tellers, shall pay a license fee of \$10.00 per day or \$50.00 per week.

Section 4P. Each and every person who, from a stand, sells or offers to sell, lemonade, cigars, ice cream, peanuts, popcorn, candy or other confectionary, shall pay a license fee of \$2.00 per day or \$5.00 per quarter.

Section 4Q. Each and every person engaged in the business or pursuit commonly known as patent medicine shows or companies, or who shall advertise as a healer, magnetic healer, faith cure, water cure, nature cure, or other similar title or designation, and who shall treat, diagnose, or prescribe, or offer to treat, diagnose or prescribe for human ailments, for a fee, gift, or other consideration, shall pay a license fee of \$10.00 per day. Provided, that nothing in this ordinance shall be construed to apply to any person or persons engaged in these occupations or professions which are licensed or regulated by the laws of the State of Idaho, or to any religious body or society within the limits of the City of Payette, Idaho.

Section 2. That Ordinance 385 be and the same is hereby repealed.
