

ORDINANCE NO. 495

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING THAT CURB LINES, WITHIN THE CITY OF PAYETTE, SHALL REMAIN AS ESTABLISHED AT THE TIME OF THE PASSAGE OF THIS ORDINANCE UNLESS CHANGED BY THE CITY COUNCIL AND GIVING THE CITY COUNCIL AUTHORITY TO ESTABLISH NEW CURB LINES WHICH ARE NOT ESTABLISHED AT THE TIME OF PASSAGE OF THIS ORDINANCE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO:

Section 1. The curb lines on all streets, within the City of Payette, shall be maintained as they have been and are established at the time of the passage of this ordinance, unless changed by the City Council, by ordinance; Provided, however, that where such curb lines are not established at the time of the passage of this ordinance the same shall be fixed by the City Council, by ordinance.
