

ORDINANCE NO. 501

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 2 OF ORDINANCE 411, AS AMENDED BY SECTION 1 OF ORDINANCE 412, FIXING THE DOG LICENSE FEES; FIXING THE TERM OF SUCH LICENSES AND DATE WHEN SAME SHALL BE PAID.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE:

Section 1. That Section 2 of Ordinance 411 as amended by Section 1 of Ordinance 412 be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 2. The City Clerk is hereby authorized to issue a license to any person applying therefor, upon the payment of two dollars per head for each dog, and four dollars per head for each bitch each and every year, provided however, that the rate for each spayed bitch shall be two dollars per head per year; the burden of proving such spayed condition to exist shall be upon the owner of such bitch, and the City Clerk shall require the owner of any spayed bitch to present a certificate of a duly licensed veterinarian, to the fact of the spaying of such bitch before issuing a license at such a fee, and otherwise the ordinary rate shall be charged as for a common bitch; said licenses to be dated from the first of the calendar year in which they are granted. Such license fee shall be due and payable on the first day of January, of each and every year. If said license is not paid on or before the first day of April of each year the City Clerk shall collect a penalty in addition to said license in the sum of One Dollar; provided however, that any dog born subsequent to April first of any year shall be licensed by the payment of the minimum fee therefor, without penalty, within three months after its birth and that thereafter the penalty shall be added as hereinabove set forth. All licenses issued hereunder shall be for the calendar year beginning with January first and expiring on December 31st.
