ORDINANCE NO. 512

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE CONSTRUCTION OF AWNINGS WITHIN THE CITY OF PAYETTE;
FIXING THE HEIGHT THE SAME SHALL BE ABOVE THE SIDEWALK AND PROVIDING PENALTY
FOR VIOLATIONS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm, association or corporation to have, keep, maintain or place any awning on buildings and structures abutting on the streets of the City of Payette, in any manner so that any part of such awnings attached to said buildings and structures shall be nearer than six and one-half feet above the surface of the sidewalk.

Section 2. Each day any person, firm, association or corporation shall have, keep or maintain any awning or any structure abutting on any street of the City of Payette in violation of Section 1 shall be deemed a separate offense, and upon conviction of the violations of this ordinance such person, firm, association or corporation shall be subject to a fine of not to exceed \$100 for each offense.
