

Ordinance No. 515

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 4 OF ORDINANCE 478 SO AS TO EXEMPT WORLD WAR I OR WORLD WAR II VETERANS' ORGANIZATION, WHICH ARE EXEMPT FROM TAXATION UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 61-105, IDAHO CODE ANNOTATED, FROM THE PROVISIONS OF SAID ORDINANCE 478 AND REPEALING ORDINANCE 506.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE:

Section 1. That Section 4 of Ordinance 478 be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 4. It is hereby declared to be unlawful for any Club, as herein defined, or manager, operator or employee thereof, to store or keep and /or serve for use or consumption on the premises of any such club any intoxicating liquor, as herein defined, and/or hold itself out or represent itself to be a "Club" or "Night Club" operating for any purpose as herein mentioned, without first obtaining a license from the City of Payette therefor, and at the same time paying the license fee as herein provided. Provided, that the provisions of this ordinance providing for the payment of a license fee shall not apply to any World War I and World War II veterans' organization, which has qualified for and is exempt from taxation, under the provisions of Section 61-105 of the Idaho Code Annotated, <sup>but</sup> all other provisions and regulations of this ordinance shall apply to such organizations notwithstanding the provisions of this exemption clause. Such license shall at all times be kept posted and displayed in a conspicuous place on the inside of the premises covered by such licensee.

Section 2. Ordinance No. 506 be and the same is hereby repealed.
