

ORDINANCE NO. 519

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 1-619, REVISED CODE OF PAYETTE, 1946, PROVIDING FOR MONTHLY CHARGES FOR CITY WATER AND PRESCRIBING THE RATES THEREFOR.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO:

SECTION 1. That Section 1-619, Revised Code of Payette, 1946, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

"1-619. Water Rates.--The monthly charges for city water shall be made and collected at the following rates, to-wit:

1. The minimum monthly charge for each meter service within the city limits shall be \$2.00, and outside the city limits shall be \$2.50. This minimum charge shall entitle the user to the delivery of four thousand (4,000) gallons of water during each such month.

2. For all amounts of water used in any month in excess of four thousand (4,000) gallons and not to exceed forty thousand (40,000) gallons, the charge shall be 25¢ for each one thousand (1,000) gallons or fraction thereof.

3. For all amounts of water used in any month in excess of forty thousand (40,000) gallons and not to exceed one hundred thousand (100,000) gallons, the charge shall be 8¢ for each one thousand (1,000) gallons, or fraction thereof.

4. For all amounts of water used in any month in excess of one hundred thousand (100,000) gallons, the charge shall be 7¢ for each one thousand (1,000) gallons or fraction thereof."
