

ORDINANCE NO. 520

51 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 9-303 REVISED CODE OF PAYETTE, 1946, PROVIDING FOR APPROVAL OF PLANS, MATERIAL, AND LOCATION OF BUILDINGS, THE REMOVAL OF SUCH BUILDINGS AND THE ISSUANCE OF BUILDING AND MOVING PERMITS.

BE IT ORDAINED By the Mayor and Council of the City of Payette, Idaho:

SECTION 1. That Section 9-303 Revised Code of Payette, 1946, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

"9-303. PERMIT REQUIRED AND PLANS, MATERIALS AND LOCATION PRESCRIBED.--No wall, structure, building or part thereof within the City of Payette, shall hereafter be built, enlarged, or altered until a plan of the proposed work together with a statement of the materials to be used, shall have been submitted to the Building Inspector or other designated official, who shall, if in accordance with the provisions herein contained, issue a permit for the proposed construction.

"All residences and private garages hereinafter constructed within the city of Payette, Idaho, shall be situate not less than twenty-five feet from the inside of the sidewalk line along the block wherein such residences or garages are to be constructed unless special permission from the City Council of the City of Payette, Idaho, is first had and obtained; no residence, outbuilding or private garage shall be hereafter constructed closer than within 8 feet of any adjoining residence, outbuilding or private garage, without special permission from the City Council so to do.

"Structures hereafter erected without permit, or not in conformity with this Chapter, shall be removed.

"No building shall be moved until a permit has been obtained from the designated official; and such official shall not issue such permit if in his judgment the proposed new location of the building would seriously increase the fire hazard of the surrounding buildings. Each building permit shall recite this section.


"No fee shall be charged for any building permit or for any permit to move a building within the City of Payette, Idaho."
