

ORDINANCE NO. 524

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 9-204 REVISED CODE OF PAYETTE, 1946, MAKING IT UNLAWFUL TO BURN RUBBISH WITHIN THE FIRE LIMITS AND AMENDING SECTION 9-205 REVISED CODE OF PAYETTE, 1946, PRESCRIBING THE PENALTY FOR SUCH UNLAWFUL BURNING.

BE IT ORDAINED BY the Mayor and Council of the City of Payette, Idaho:

SECTION 1. That Section 9-204 Revised Code of Payette, 1946, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

"9-204. UNLAWFUL TO BURN RUBBISH.--It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to burn on any street, alley or lot within the fire limits of the City of Payette, any paper, trash or rubbish."

SECTION 2. That Section 9-205 Revised Code of Payette, 1946, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

"9-205. FIRES IN STREETS OR ALLEYS.--Any person who shall kindle any fire upon any street, alley or lot within the said fire limits, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined in any sum not less than two dollars nor more than one hundred dollars."
