

ORDINANCE NO. 540

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 2-916 OF THE REVISED CODES OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE RELATING TO PERSONS, FIRMS OR CORPORATIONS TEMPORARILY ENGAGED IN BUSINESS IN THE CITY OF PAYETTE, DEFINING WHAT CONSTITUTES TEMPORARILY ENGAGED IN BUSINESS AND PROVIDING THE LICENSE FEE TO BE PAID FOR OPERATING SUCH BUSINESS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1 That Section 2-916 of the Revised Codes of the City of Payette be, and hereby it is amended to read as follows:

It shall be unlawful for any person, persons, firm or corporation to temporarily engage in the business of selling merchandise, making and selling pictures and/or photographs, or engaging in any line of business within the City of Payette, without procuring licenses therefor from the City Clerk authorizing the carrying on of such business and paying therefor the following license fees, to-wit: The sum of \$15.00 per day from the owner, proprietor or manager of such business, and \$10.00 per day from each clerk, solicitor or other employee in the operation of such business, for each day such business is carried on, and the fees of the Clerk for issuing such license or licenses. By temporarily engaging in business is meant the opening up and selling of goods or operating such line or lines of business within the City for a few days only without any intent to remain permanently in the business, such as owners of other places selling goods and/or pictures and photographs and engaging in such other lines of business.
