ORDINANCE NO. 608

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 6 OF TITLE 4 OF REVISED CODE OF PAYETTE, 1946, BY ADDING TO SAID CHAPTER A NEW SECTION DESIGNATED AS SECTION 4-616 VACATING BY PROPER DESCRIPTION A PORTION OF THIRD AVENUE NORTH IN THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, UPON CERTAIN CONDITIONS AND PROVIDING THAT THE VACATED PORTION SHALL PASS TO AND BECOME A PART OF THE ABUTTING REAL ESTATE ON THE NORTH SIDE OF SAID THIRD AVENUE NORTH.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO.

Section 1. That Chapter 6 of Title 4 of Revised Code of Payette, 1946, be, and the same is hereby amended by adding thereto Section 4-616 which reads as follows:

"4-616. PART OF THIRD AVENUE NORTH VACATED.--That the following described portion of Third Avenue North, to-wit:

a 10-foot strip of land lying immediately South and being adjacent to and adjoining the following described premises: Lot 1 and the West 5 feet of Lot 2, Block 10 of Corrie's Addition to Payette, Idaho, and a certain tract of land described as follows -- Beginning at the Southwest corner of Block 10 of Corrie's Addition, thence West 20 feet; thence 54.1 feet North; thence 20 feet East; thence 54.1 feet South to the point of beginning. Said tract being more particularly described as follows: Beginning at a point 5 feet East of the Southeast corner of Lot 1, Block 10 of Corrie's Addition to Payette, Idaho, thence South 10 feet; thence West 55 feet; thence North 10 feet; thence East 55 feet to the point of beginning;

be, and the same is hereby, vacated, and closed, and said vacated portion shall revert to and become a part of the abutting real estate on the North side of said Third Avenue North upon the express condition, however, that this Ordinance is subject to the provisions of that certain agreement made and entered into the 30th day of October, 1957, by and between the City of Payette, Idaho, a municipal corporation, and James R. Meehan and Ruby Lue Meehan, husband and wife,"
