

ORDINANCE NO. 667


AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 10 CHAPTER 15 SECTION 9 (D) TO PROVIDE THAT AFTER THE FIRST SEVENTY-TWO (72) HOURS OF A PARKING VIOLATION, THAT IF THE TWENTY-FIVE (25¢) CENTS IS NOT PAID BY SAID VIOLATOR WITHIN THE FIRST SEVENTY-TWO (72) HOURS FROM THE TIME WRITTEN ON THE VIOLATION TICKET OR ENVELOPE THE VIOLATOR WILL BE ARRESTED BY AN ENFORCEMENT ORDINANCE WHICH SHALL BE ISSUED BY THE POLICE DEPARTMENT AND AN ASSESSMENT OF A FINE IN THE AMOUNT OF FIVE (\$5.00) DOLLARS WILL BE COLLECTED FROM THE VIOLATOR.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, THAT THE FOLLOWING ORDINANCE IS HEREBY AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

Title 10 Chapter 15 Section 9 (D), the 2nd Paragraph thereof is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Each such police officer shall attach to such vehicle a notice printed upon an envelope to the owner or operator thereof that such vehicle has been parked in violation of a provision of this Chapter and instructing such owner or operator to either deposit the required penalty in the envelope and drop it in a box to be erected for said purposes within the parking zone or report at the Clerk's office in the City with regard to such violation, within the first seventy-two (72) hours from the time written on the violation ticket or envelope the violator may deposit with the City Clerk's office, or may deposit in the envelope and place said envelope in the container for such purposes, the sum of twenty five (25¢) cents, as a penalty for and in full satisfaction of such violation." That after seventy-two (72) hours have elapsed from the time written on the violation ticket or envelope, a warrant will be issued by the police officers of the City of Payette, and there shall be assessed a fine of Five (\$5.00) Dollars against the violator of this ordinance.
