

ORDINANCE NO. 668

AN ORDINANCE VACATING CERTAIN LANDS WITHIN THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, AND PROVIDING THAT THE VACATED LANDS SHALL REVERT TO THE OWNERS OF THE ABUTTING REAL ESTATE AND BECOME A PART OF SUCH ABUTTING LOTS AND EXISTING EASEMENTS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO:

Section 1. That the following described premises are hereby vacated to the abutting owner, the Oregon Shortline Railroad, a corporation, being not necessary to the regular streets and alleys of the City of Payette; that the same shall revert to the abutting owners of the City of Payette:

Beginning at a point 26.5 ft. West of the Southwest Corner of Lot 20 in Block 8 of Gorrie Addition as recorded in Page 19, Book 1 of plats in the office of the Payette County Recorder, Payette, Idaho, said point being approximately on the Westerly side of the alley adjacent to the Northwesterly side of said Block 8 of Gorrie Addition; thence West along the North right-of-way line of 2nd Avenue North 175 ft.; thence South 12 ft.; thence East 170 ft. more or less to the Westerly side of afore-said alley; thence in a Northeasterly direction to the point of beginning.

Section 2. That all easements now in existence under, in and upon the lands forming the above described property shall remain and be in full force and effect.
