

ORDINANCE NO. 700

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER NO. 5-5-13 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, RELATING TO DAYS PERSONS ALLOWED UPON PREMISES WHERE LIQUOR IS SOLD TO PROVIDE FOR THE REMOVAL FROM SAID SECTION OF THE RESTRICTION FOR PEOPLE BEING UPON THE PREMISES OF A LIQUOR LICENSEE ON SUNDAY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO:

That Section 5-5-13 of the Municipal Code of the City of Payette be, and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

PERSONS UPON PREMISES: Except as hereinafter provided it shall be unlawful for any person to be present upon any licensed premises for any purposes whatsoever during the following hours:

- (A) Memorial Day, Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day from 1:15 A.M. to 10:00 A.M. the following day.
- (B) On any other day between 1:15 A.M. and 10:00 A.M.
- (C) On any day of a general or primary election until after the time when the polls are closed.

This section shall not apply to the owner of the business if any individual; to members of the partnership or association or officers or members of the governing board of a corporation when actually engaged in work which must be performed upon the premises, if the licensee be a partnership, association or corporation; to bartenders licensed hereunder regularly employed in or upon the licensed premises; nor to laborers or craftsmen employed for work upon the licensed premises between the hours of 8:00 A.M. and 6:00 P.M. of any day.
