

AN ORDINANCE DELETING THE PROVISION CONTAINED IN SECTION 1-11-5 THAT EACH OF THE THREE (3) WARDS OF THE CITY SHALL HAVE ONE (1) MEMBER OF THE COUNCIL ON EACH OF THE STANDING COMMITTEES AND AMENDING CHAPTER 11 OF TITLE 1 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO BY ADDING SECTIONS 1-11-6, 1--11-7, and 1-11-8 TO THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO TO PROVIDE FOR COMPULSORY ATTENDANCE OF CITY COUNCIL MEMBERS WHO ARE ABSENT FROM REGULAR OR SPECIAL MEETINGS OF THE CITY COUNCIL WITHOUT LEAVE, AND TO PROVIDE FOR FORFEITURE OF SALARIES OF COUNCIL MEMBERS WHO ARE ABSENT WITHOUT LEAVE.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of Payette, Idaho that Chapter 11 of Title 1 of the Municipal Code of the City of Payette, Idaho be amended by deleting certain provisions in Section 1-11-5 and by adding sections 1-11-6, 1-11-7, and 1-11-8 to Chapter 11 of Title 1 of the Municipal Code of the City of Payette, Idaho, and that the same shall read as follows:

Section 1-11-5 Standing Committees: All standing committees of the Council that are hereafter appointed or may hereafter be provided for, shall consist of three (3) members of the Council; ~~and each of the three (3) wards of the City shall have (1) member of the Council on each of the standing committees;~~ provided however, that the committee on health, drainage and cemetery shall consist of the entire Council, and the Mayor shall be ex officio Chairman of said committee.

Section 1-11-6 Leave of Absence: No Council Member, unless from illness or other reasonable cause which makes him unable to be in attendance, shall absent himself from any special or regular meeting of the City Council without first having obtained leave of absence from the Mayor or the President of the City Council.

Section 1-11-7 Compelling Attendance: A majority of the Council Members present at any regular or special meeting of the City Council may order the arrest of Council Members not in attendance and who are absent without leave.

The form of warrant for the arrest of Council Members who are absent without leave shall be as follows:

To the Chief of Police or the police officers of the City of Payette, Idaho:

Whereas, the City Council has adopted the following order: That the Chief of Police or the police officers of the City of Payette, Idaho take into custody and bring to the meeting of the City Council such Council Members as are found absent without leave; and

Whereas, the following named members of the City Council are absent without leave, to-wit:

Now, therefore, I _____, Mayor of the City of Payette, Idaho (or President of the City Council of the City of Payette, Idaho), by virtue of the power vested in

me by the City Council, hereby command you to execute the said Order of the City Council, by taking into custody and bringing to the meeting of the City Council at _____ on the _____ day of _____, 19____, said above named Council Members who are so absent without leave; hereof fail not, and make due return in what manner you executed the same.

Section 1-11-8 Forfeiture of Salaries: Whenever a Council Member, who without reasonable cause, absents himself from a regular or special meeting of the City Council without first having obtained leave of absence from the Mayor or President of Council, although the Council Member may have been subsequently compelled to attend by virtue of Section 1-11-7, such Council Member shall forfeit one-half of the salary that he receives each month for services performed by him as a Council Member.

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the Independent-Enterprise, a newspaper of general circulation in the City of Payette, Idaho.
