

ORDINANCE NO. 836

AN ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 2 OF CHAPTER 4 OF TITLE 4 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, BY ADDING A SUBSECTION WHICH AMENDS THE REQUIREMENTS AS CONTAINED IN SECTION 403 OF THE UNIFORM SIGN CODE RELATING TO THE PROJECTION, CLEARANCE AND THICKNESS OF SIGNS.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of Payette, Idaho that Section 2 of Chapter 4 of Title 4 of the Municipal Code of the City of Payette, Idaho, be amended to read as follows:


4-4-2: AMENDMENTS: The sign code as herein adopted and incorporated by reference is hereby amended as follows:

- (A) Sub-section 3 of Section 303 is hereby deleted.
- (B) Section 1401 of the Uniform Sign Code shall read as follows: No temporary sign shall exceed 100 square feet in area. Temporary signs of rigid material shall not exceed 24 square feet in area or 6 feet in height, nor shall any such sign be fastened to the ground. Temporary signs may remain in place for a period not exceeding 60 days, unless otherwise allowed or permitted by the legislative body. (Ord. 831;6-16-75)
- (C) Table No. 4-B is amended in its entirety to read as follows: Clearance less than 8 feet, no projection permitted; clearance of 8 feet, 1 foot projection permitted; clearance of 9 feet or more, no restriction on projection except that the sign shall not project within 2 feet of the curb line.
- (D) Table No. 4-C is modified to provide the following maximum thickness allowed for signs projecting more than 5 feet: 6 feet projection, maximum thickness one foot, 6 inches; 7 feet projection, maximum thickness one foot; projection of 8 feet or more, maximum thickness 6 inches.

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the Independent Enterprise, a newspaper of general circulation in the City of Payette, Idaho.
