

An Ordinance

1 AN ORDINANCE REPEALING SECTIONS 4-2-2 and 4-2-3 OF THE MUNICIPAL  
2 CODE OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO; AMENDING SECTION 1 OF CHAPTER 1 OF TITLE  
3 4 TO PROVIDE FOR THE ADOPTION OF THE 1974 AND 1975 SUPPLEMENTS TO THE UNIFORM  
4 BUILDING CODE AND THE FOLLOWING CODES:

5 THE UNIFORM BUILDING CODE, 1973, 1975 SUPPLEMENT, AND THE APPENDICES  
6 THERE-TO;  
7 THE UNIFORM HOUSING CODE, 1973, PUBLISHED BY THE INTERNATIONAL CON-  
8 FERENCE OF BUILDING OFFICIALS;  
9 THE UNIFORM CODE OF ABATEMENT OF DANGEROUS BUILDINGS, 1973, PUBLISHED  
10 BY THE INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE OF BUILDING OFFICIALS;

11 THE UNIFORM MECHANICAL CODE, 1973, PUBLISHED BY THE INTERNATIONAL  
12 CONFERENCE OF BUILDING OFFICIALS AND THE INTERNATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF PLUMBING  
13 AND MECHANICAL OFFICIALS;

14 AMERICAN STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS FOR MAKING BUILDINGS AND FACILITIES  
15 ACCESSIBLE TO, AND USABLE BY, THE PHYSICALLY HANDICAPPED, ANSI A117.1-1961 (R-  
16 1971), PUBLISHED BY THE AMERICAN NATIONAL STANDARDS INSTITUTE;

17 THE ASME BOILER AND PRESSURE VESSEL CODE-1971, AND THE ASME POWER  
18 PIPING CODE (ANSI B31.1-1973), ALL PUBLISHED BY THE AMERICAN SOCIETY OF MECHANICAL  
19 ENGINEERS;

20 THE UNIFORM FIRE CODE, 1973, WITH APPENDICES THERETO, PUBLISHED BY  
21 THE WESTERN FIRE CHIEFS ASSOCIATION AND THE INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE OF  
22 BUILDING OFFICIALS, AND THE LIFE SAFETY CODE, NATIONAL FIRE PROTECTION ASSOCI-  
23 ATION CODE NUMBER 101-1973, PUBLISHED BY THE NATIONAL FIRE PROTECTION ASSOCI-  
24 ATION;

25 NATIONAL FIRE PROTECTION ASSOCIATION CODE NUMBERS 501A-1974, AND  
26 501D-1974, PUBLISHED BY THE NATIONAL FIRE PROTECTION ASSOCIATION; AND  
27 NATIONAL FIRE PROTECTION ASSOCIATION CODE NUMBER 54-1974 (ANSI Z223.1)  
28 AND THE APPENDICES THERETO, AS IT PERTAINS TO NATURAL GAS, AND NATIONAL FIRE  
29 PROTECTION ASSOCIATION NUMBER 59A-1972, BOTH PUBLISHED BY THE NATIONAL FIRE  
30 PROTECTION ASSOCIATION; EXCEPT THAT THESE CODES SHALL NOT BE APPLICABLE TO  
31 GASES PRODUCED AS A BY-PRODUCT INTERVAL TO THE PROCESS OF MANUFACTURE.

32 REPEALING CHAPTER 5 OF TITLE 7 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE AND PROVIDING  
33 THAT THE PLANNING AND ZONING COMMISSION SHALL CONSTITUTE THE BOARD OF APPEALS,  
34 AND REPEALING ALL SECTIONS OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO  
35 THAT ARE IN DIRECT CONFLICT WITH SAID UNIFORM CODES.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Payette,

Idaho:

That Section 4-1-1 of the Municipal Code be amended as hereinafter  
set forth that the provisions of Sections 4-2-2 and 4-2-3 of the Municipal  
Code be and the same are hereby repealed, that chapter 5 of title 7 of the  
Municipal Code be and the same is hereby repealed; That chapter I of title 4  
be amended to add a new section 4-1-2:

4-1-1: ADOPTION: That certain document, three (3) copies of each  
of which are in the office of the Clerk, being worded and designated,  
The Uniform Building Code, 1973, 1975 Supplement, and the appendices  
thereto;

The Uniform Housing Code, 1973, published by the International Confer-

1           ence of Building Officials;

2           The Uniform Code for Abatement of Dangerous Buildings, 1973, pub-  
3           lished by the International Conference of Building Officials;

4           The Uniform Mechanical Code, 1973, published by the International  
5           Conference of Building Officials and the International Association of Plumb-  
6           ing and Mechanical Officials;

7           American Standard Specifications for Making Buildings and Facilities  
8           Accessible to, and Usable, by, the Physically Handicapped, ANSI A117.1-1961  
9           (R-1971), published by the American National Standards Institute;

10           The ASME Boiler and Pressure Vessel Code-1971, and the ASME Power  
11           Piping Code (ANSI B31.1-1973), all published by the American Society of Mechani-  
12           cal Engineers;

13           The Uniform Fire Code, 1973, with appendices thereto, published by the  
14           Western Fire Chiefs Association and the International Conference of Building  
15           Officials, and the Life Safety Code, National Fire Protection Association Code  
16           number 101-1973, published by the National Fire Protection Association;

17           National Fire Protection Association Code numbers 501A-1974, and  
18           501D-1974, published by the National Fire Protection Association; and  
19           National Fire Protection Association Code number 54-1974 (ANSI Z223.1)  
20           and the appendices thereto, as it pertains to natural gas, and National Fire  
21           Protection Association number 59A-1972, both published by the National Fire  
22           Association; except that, these codes shall not be applicable to gases produced  
23           as a by-product internal to the process of manufacture.

24           are hereby adopted by the City to provide for the regulations set  
25           forth therein and providing for the issuance of permits and collection of fees  
26           therefore, which documents are on file in the office of the Clerk and hereby  
27           made a part hereof by reference in the same manner as though fully set forth  
28           in this chapter, notwithstanding any existing conflicting Sections contained  
29           in the Municipal Code which by this adoption are hereby repealed, excepting  
30           such portions as are hereafter amended, deleted, or modified.

31           4-1-2: The Planning and Zoning Commission of the City shall consti-  
32           tute the Appeals Board which is referred to in the Uniform Codes adopted by  
33           reference in Section 4-1-1 of this Municipal Code.
