

ORDINANCE NO.1530

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE STATE OF IDAHO; AMENDING THE PAYETTE MUNICIPAL CODE TITLE 2 ADMINISTRATION AND PERSONNEL, CHAPTER 2.04 MAYOR; CITY COUNCIL, SECTION 2.04.010 SALARIES, ESTABLISHING THE COMPENSATION FOR THE MAYOR AND COUNCILMEMBERS OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, REPEALING CONFLICTING ORDINANCES, PROVIDING SEVERABILITY, CODIFICATION, PUBLICATION BY SUMMARY, AND ESTABLISHING EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PAYETTE CITY COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Payette Municipal Code Title 2 ADMINISTRATION & PERSONNEL, Chapter 2.04 MAYOR; CITY COUNCIL, Section 2.04.010 SALARIES is hereby amended to read as follows:

2.04.010: SALARIES:

Effective January 1, ~~1988~~ 2024, the salaries of the Mayor and of the members of the Payette City Council shall be as follows:

(a) The Mayor shall receive for his services as Mayor ~~five hundred dollars (\$500.00) per month~~ an annual salary in the sum of six-thousand dollars (\$6,000.00); and

(b) Each ~~councilman~~ member of the Council shall receive for his services ~~three hundred dollars (\$300.00) per month~~ an annual salary in the sum of three thousand six-hundred dollars (\$3,600.00).

(c) The Mayor and Council shall receive the same employee benefits as any full-time city employee, excluding any dependents, except for accrual of vacation or sick leave.

Section 2. This Ordinance may be published in summary form allowed by Idaho Code.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon passage and publication as required by the laws of the State of Idaho.

Section 4. Any ordinances or resolutions which are in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed, but only insofar as the conflict exists.

Section 5. If any portion of this Ordinance should be found to be unconstitutional or unenforceable for any reason, the remainder of the Ordinance shall be applied to effectuate the purposes of this Ordinance.
