

ORDINANCE NO. 100 BY W. P. ACKERMAN.

AN ORDINANCE MAKING IT UNLAWFUL, TO SELL OR GIVE AWAY TO ANY MINOR ANY CIGARETTE OR CIGARETTE PAPER, AND FOR ANY MINOR TO PURCHASE OR ACCEPT ANY CIGARETTE, CIGARETTES OR CIGARETTE PAPER, OR TO SMOKE ANY CIGARETTE, CIGARETTES, CIGARETTE PAPER OR ANYTHING THAT PURPORTS TO BE A CIGARETTE, AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

Be it Ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of Payette:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any merchant, trader, druggist or any other person or persons, within the corporate limits of the City of Payette, with or without license, to either sell or give away, directly or indirectly, to any person or persons under the age of twenty one (21) years, any cigarette, cigarettes or cigarette paper.

Section 2. It shall be unlawful for any minor, within the corporate limits of the City of Payette, to purchase or accept any cigarette, cigarettes or cigarette paper or to smoke any cigarette, cigarettes, cigarette paper or anything ~~that~~ purporting, ^{to be} or resembling a cigarette.

Section 3. Any person or persons violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined in any sum not exceeding one hundred (\$100) dollars or imprisoned in the city jail not exceeding 30 days.
