ORDINANCE NO. 103RY BY W. P. ACKERMAN.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 1 OF ORDINANCE NO. 93 ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE REMOVAL OF GRASS AND OTHER OBSTRUCTIONS FROM STREETS AND SIDEWALKS AND REQUIRING IRRIGATION DITCHES TO BE KEPT FREE OF OBSTRUCTIONS."

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of Payette:

Section 1. That section 1 of ordinance No. 93 entitled "An ordinance relating to the removal of grass and other obstructions from streets and sidewalks and requiring irrigation ditches to be kept free of obstructions," passed by the Mayor and Council of the City of Payette, ~~on the xxxxxxxx day~~ and approved by the Mayor thereof, on the 19th day of July, 1907, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 1. Every owner or occupant of any property, within the corporate limits of the City of Payette, shall remove and keep removed all papers, weeds, rubbish and underbrush, from all streets and sidewalks adjoining the property so owned or occupied, as far as the curb line; and the owner or owners of all vacant lots within the city, shall be required to cut and remove the weeds therefrom, when the same become unsightly, a nuisance, deleterious to the health of the people or a menace to any property.
