AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO ROAD WAYS, SIDEWALKS, GRADING OF STREETS,  
AND THE ESTABLISHMENT AND CONSTRUCTION OF CURB LINES AND CURBS, AND  
PROVIDING THAT THE COST FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF CURBS SHALL BE TAXED  
AGAINST THE ABUTTING PROPERTY.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of Payette, Idaho:

**Section 1.** That along all streets in the City of Payette, Idaho, 120 feet in width, the road way shall be 60 feet wide; along all streets 100 feet in width, the road way shall be 50 feet wide, except along Boise Street, the road way shall be 60 feet wide; along all streets less than 100 feet in width, the road way shall be 60 % of the entire width of the street, and the center of each road way shall be the center of each street, and all that portion of any street on either side of the road way, shall be deemed and taken as sidewalk.

**Section 2.** That each street shall be graded in the following manner and conform to the established grade; the center of the road way shall be on the established grade, the bottom of the gutter on each side of the road way shall be 15 inches below the center of the road way, and shall be adjoining that portion of the street taken as sidewalk, next to the curb. The road way shall be graded on a regular curve across the street. The curb shall be of cut stone or concrete; if made of concrete, the same must have at least one part cement to eight of sand and gravel, covered with a plaster made with one part cement to two of sand ~~xxx xxxxxx~~; the curbs shall be not less than eight inches at the bottom and six at the top, and eighteen inches deep with a two inch batter on the side next to the road way; the top of the curb shall be on a level with the center of the road way, and the sidewalk shall raise 1/8 of an inch to the foot from the top of curb to building line; on alley corners the curb shall be turned on a radius of three feet and on street corners, on a radius of ten feet.

**Section 3.** The parties whose property fronts and adjoins the street on which the curb is to be laid shall be required to put the same down within thirty days after being notified in writing by the City Marshal. In case the same is not put down within said thirty days, then it shall be the duty of the City of Payette, Idaho, to put the said curb down and the costs and expenses of such work shall be taxed and assessed against the abutting property, and shall be certified to the County assessor and Tax collector in the same manner as other city taxes, and shall be collected as such taxes.
