

ORDINANCE NO. 138 BY BRAINARD.

ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A CEMENT SIDEWALK ON THE EAST AND WEST SIDES OF PARK STREET; AND PROVIDING WHAT THE DISTANCE SHALL BE BETWEEN THE CENTER OF THE SIDEWALK AND THE BUILDING LINE.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of Payette, Idaho:

Section 1. That a cement sidewalk shall be constructed on the East and West sides of Park Street; said sidewalks shall be five feet wide, constructed of good portland cement, and sand and gravel, mixed in the proportion of one part of cement to eight of sand and gravel, covered with a plaster made from one part of cement to three of sand; the same shall be according to the plans and specifications provided for in ordinance No. 48, except as herein otherwise provided.

Section 2. The sidewalk herein provided for shall be constructed by the property owners, and each property owner shall be required to construct the said sidewalk in front of his property within 30 days after the same is ordered in by the Mayor and City Council; and in case the said sidewalk is not constructed by the said property owner or owners within the said time provided for by the said Mayor and Council, then it shall be the duty of the City of Payette to construct the same, and the costs and expenses of such construction shall be taxed against the property fronting thereon; the owners of all corner lots shall be required to construct the sidewalk to the outer edge of the curb line.

Section 3. The distance between the building line and the center of the sidewalk of all sidewalks hereafter constructed on Park Street shall be thirteen feet.
