

ORDINANCE NO. 145 BY

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING A LICENSE TAX FROM POP CORN AND PEANUT VENDERS;  
AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of Payette, Idaho:

Section 1. It shall be and hereby is made unlawful for any person, firm or association to engage in selling peanuts and popcorn, or either ~~one~~, on any street, alley, avenue, side walk, theater or other public place within the City of Payette, Idaho, without first obtaining a license from the said City. Each and every person who engages in the vending of either peanuts or popcorn or both shall pay a quarterly license to the said City of Five dollars per quarter.

Section 2. Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined in any sum not exceeding \$50.00, or thirty days in the City jail, or both such fine and imprisonment.
