

ORDINANCE NO. 150 BY L. S. Soule

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING CHICKENS, DUCKS, GEESE, TURKEYS AND OTHER POULTRY FROM RUNNING AT LARGE WITHING THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, BETWEEN CERTAIN DATES, AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of Payette, Idaho:

Section 1. It shall be and hereby is made unlawful for any person, firm, association or corporation to keep any chickens, ducks, geese, turkeys or other poultry within City of Payette, Idaho, ~~between the~~ during the months of April, May, June, July, August and September of each and every year, except the same shall be confined within a shed, pen or enclosure sufficient to retain said chickens, ducks, geese, turkeys or other poultry from tresspassing upon the streets, alleys and other property within the said City of Payette.

Section 2. It shall be and hereby is made unlawful for any person, firm, association or corporation to permit or allow any chickens, ducks, geese, turkeys or other poultry to run at large upon the streets, alleys, occupied or unoccupied lots or other land ~~within~~ not belonging to the owner ~~of the chickens, ducks, geese, turkeys or other poultry~~ thereof, ~~between~~ during the months of April, May, June, July, August & September, within the corporate limits of the City of Payette, Idaho.

Section 3. Any person, firm, association or corporation violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined not to exceed \$25.

and on the City jail not to exceed 10 days.

ORDINANCE NO. 150

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING CHICKENS, DUCKS, GESE, TURKEYS AND OTHER POULTRY FROM RUNNING AT LARGE WITHIN THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, BETWEEN CERTAIN DATES, AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of Payette, Idaho:

Section 1. It shall be and hereby is made unlawful for any person, firm, association or corporation to keep any chickens, ducks, geese, turkeys or other poultry within City of Payette, Idaho, during the months of April, May, June, July, August, and September of each and every year,

except the same shall be confined within a shed, pen or enclosure sufficient to retain said chickens, ducks, geese, turkeys or other poultry from trespassing upon the streets, alleys and other property within the said City of Payette.

Section 2. It shall be and hereby is made unlawful for any person, firm, association or corporation to permit or allow any chickens, ducks, geese, turkeys or other poultry to run at large upon the streets, alleys, occupied or unoccupied lots or other land not belonging to the owner thereof, during the months of April, May, June, July, August and September, within the corporate limits of the City of Payette, Idaho.

Section 3. Any person, firm, association or corporation violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined not to exceed \$25 or imprisoned in the city jail not to exceed 10 days.
