ORDINANCE NO. 152

By Burns.

ANNUAL APPROPRIATION BILL
OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE,
IDAHO.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and
Council of the City of Payette, Ida-
ho:

Section 1. That there is hereby
levied for the fiscal year, commenc-
ing in the 1st Tuesday in May, 1909,
against all the taxable property with-
in the corporate limits of the City of
Payette, Idaho, the sum of 2 mills
on each one dollar of the assessed val-
uation of such property, and the funds
realized from such levy, together
with all licenses and fines shall be
placed in the general fund of the
City of Payette.

Section 2. That there is hereby
levied for the fiscal year commenc-
ing on the 1st Tuesday in May, 1909,
against all the taxable property with-
in the corporate limits of the City of
Payette, Idaho, the sum of 3 mills on
each one dollar of the assessed val-
uation of such property, and the funds
realized from such levy shall be
placed in the road fund of the said
City of Payette.

Section 3. That there is hereby
levied for the fiscal year commenc-
ing on the 1st Tuesday in May, 1909,
against all taxable property within
the corporate limits of the City of
Payette, Idaho, the sum of 5 mills on
each one dollar of the assessed val-
uation of such property, and the funds
realized from such levy shall be
placed in the salary fund of the City
of Payette.

Section 4. That there is hereby
levied for the fiscal year commenc-
ing on the 1st Tuesday in May, 1909,
against all the taxable property with-
in the corporate limits of the City of
Payette, Idaho, the sum of 4 mills on
each one dollar of the assessed val-
uation of such property, and the funds
realized from such levy shall be
placed in the Water Works Bond In-
terest fund and be expended in the
payment of the interest that has ac-
crued or may accrue on the thirty
thousand dollar municipal coupon
bonds heretofore issued by the said
City of Payette.

Section 5. That there is hereby
levied for the fiscal year commenc-
ing on the 1st Tuesday of May, 1909,
against all the taxable property with-
in the corporate limits of the City of
Payette, Idaho, the sum of ½ mill on
each one dollar of the assessed val-
uation of such property, and the
funds realized from such levy shall
be placed in the Water Works Bond
Sinking fund, which money shall be
expended in paying the principal of
the thirty thousand dollar Municipal
Water Works Bonds heretofore is-
sued by the City of Payette, at the
maturity thereof.

ORDINANCE NO. # 152 BY Burns

ANNUAL APPROPRIATION BILL OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of Payette, Idaho:

Section 1. That there is hereby levied for the fiscal year, commencing in the 1st Tuesday in May, 1909, against all the taxable property within the corporate limits of the City of Payette, Idaho, the sum of 2 mills on each one dollar of the assessed valuation of such property, and the funds realized from such levy, together with all licenses and fines shall be placed in the general fund of the City of Payette.

Section 2. That there is hereby levied for the fiscal year commencing on the 1st Tuesday in May, 1909, against all the taxable property within the corporate limits of the City of Payette, Idaho, the sum of 3 Mills on each one dollar of the assessed valuation of such property, and the funds realized from such levy shall be placed in the road fund of the said City of Payette.

Section 3. That there is hereby levied for the fiscal year commencing on the 1st Tuesday in May, 1909, against all the taxable property within the corporate limits of the ~~said~~ City of Payette, Idaho, the sum of 5 mills on each one dollar of the assessed valuation of such property, and the funds realized from such levy shall be placed in the salary fund of the City of Payette.

Section 4. That there is hereby levied for the fiscal year commencing on the 1st Tuesday in May, 1909, against all the taxable property within the corporate limits of the City of Payette, ^{Idaho,} the sum of 4 mills on each one dollar of the assessed valuation of such property, and the funds realized from such levy shall ~~shall~~ be placed in the Water Works Bond Interest fund and be expended in the payment of the interest that has accrued or may accrue on the thirty thousand dollar municipal coupon bonds heretofore issued by the said City of Payette.

Section 5. That there is hereby levied for the fiscal year commencing on the 1st Tuesday of May, 1909, against all the taxable property within the corporate limits of the City of Payette, Idaho, the sum of 1/2 mills on each one dollar of the assessed valuation of such property,

and the funds realized from such levy shall be placed in the Water Works Bond Sinking fund, which money shall be expended in paying the principal of the thirty thousand dollar Municipal Water Works Bonds heretofore issued by the City of Payette, at the maturity thereof.
