

SPECIAL ORDINANCE NO. 162 BY

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AN ORDINANCE DECLARING THE INTENTION OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE TO ESTABLISH WITHIN THE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE A LOCAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT TO BE CALLED "LOCAL SEWERAGE IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 3" AND THE INTENTION OF THE SAID CITY TO ESTABLISH THEREIN A SEWERAGE SYSTEM AND GIVING NOTICE OF THE TIME WITHIN WHICH PROTESTS AGAINST SAID IMPROVEMENT MAY BE MADE.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of Payette, Idaho:

Section 1. That it is the intention of the City of Payette, to establish within the limits of the said city a local improvement district to be called "Local Sewerage Improvement District No. 3" and to construct a sewerage system therein.

Section 2. The boundaries of the said proposed Sewerage District are as follows: Beginning at the North-east corner of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 28, Township 9 North, Range 5 West of the Boise Meridian, in Canyon County, Idaho, thence North 1320 feet; thence East 500 feet; thence North 196 feet; thence West 300 feet; thence South 196 feet; thence West along the ~~North line~~ North line of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of said Section 28, 660 feet; thence North and parallel to said Section line 1320 feet; thence West along the North line of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of said Section 28, 660 feet; to the West line the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of said Section 28; thence South along the West line of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of said Section 28, 271.2 feet; thence West 660 feet; thence South and parallel to the East line of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of said Section 28, 2325 feet to the South line of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of said Section 28; thence East ~~660~~ ~~foot~~ along said South line 660 feet to the West line of SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  said Section 28; thence East and parallel to the North line of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 28, 660 feet; thence North and parallel to the <sup>said ~~North line~~</sup> East line of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of said Section 28, 330 feet; thence East along the North line of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of said Section 28, ~~660~~ ~~foot~~ 660 feet to the point ~~on the East line~~ of beginning; also beginning at a point 132 feet West of the South-east corner of ~~said~~ said Section 28, thence in a Northeasterly direction along said right of way 2207.2 feet; thence West 720 feet more or less to the East line of said Section 28; thence South

along said East line of said section 28, to the intersection of the West line of the Oregon Short Line Railways company's right of way; thence in a Southwesterly direction along said right of way to the South line of said Section 28; thence East along said ~~line~~ section line to the place of beginning.

Section 3. That said sewer system shall be a gravity system, ~~constructed~~ constructed of pipes of suitable sizes to carry off the sewage from the entire district, with manholes; that the main discharging sewer shall run down Front street to a certain waste ditch and then in a Northwesterly direction to the Snake River, with laterals through the said district sufficient to cover the same and carry off the sewage from the entire district.

Section 4. The estimated cost <sup>for</sup> ~~of~~ the construction of the ~~said~~ said improvement is the sum of \$1.75 per front foot of the frontage of the same, making a total sum of \$15000.

Section 5. That the cost of the construction of the said sewer system in the said Local Sewerage Improvement District shall be assessed against all the lots and parcels of land lying and being within the boundaries of the said district as set forth in section 2 of this ordinance Provided However that the property occupied by the streets, cross streets and alleys shall be paid for by the City of Payette.

Section 6. That protests against the establishment of the said Local Sewerage Improvement District No. 3 as in this ordinance provided may be filed with the City Clerk before 8 o'clock P. M. on the 14<sup>th</sup> day of April, 1910, at which time said protests will be heard by the said Mayor and Council.
