

ORDINANCE NO. 196 BY Burns

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE STANDING OF DRAY WAGONS AND OTHER VEHICLES UPON CERTAIN STREETS WITHIN THE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF RAYETTE.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of Rayette:

Section 1. It shall be and hereby is unlawful for any dray wagon or other vehicle used for the carrying of freight, express, merchandise or baggage, to stand upon 8th street between 1st Avenue South and ~~and~~ 2nd Avenue North, while waiting for custom.

Section 2. Any person or persons violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, ~~on~~ upon conviction, be fined in any sum not exceeding one hundred dollars.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval and publication in the official newspaper.
