ORDINANCE NO. 197 BY Burns

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCES NUMBER ~~EXX~~ 162 AND NUMBER 168 OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of Payette:

Section 1. That Special ordinance No. 162 of the City of Payette, entitled " An ordinance declaring the intention of the City of Payette, to establish within the limits of the City of Payette a local improvement district to be called "Local <sup>SEWERAGE</sup> Improvement District No. 3" and the intention of said City to establish therein a sewerage system and giving notice of the time within which protests against said improvement may be made, passed and approved on the 31st, day of March, 1910; also ordinance No. 168, entitled "An ordinance creating and establishing local sewerage improvement District No. 3 within the City of Payette, ordering the construction thereof, defining the duties of the ~~sewer~~ sewer committee, providing for the levy of a special assessment to defray the expenses of constructing a sewer system and providing the manner of Payment thereof", passed and approved on the 13th day January, 1911, be and the same hereby are repealed.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage, approval and publication in the official newspaper.
