

ORDINANCE NO. 213. *By Burns*

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR LICENSING OF DRAYMAN, PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF, AND REPEALING ALL OTHER ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE.

First: That each and every person, firm or corporation who hauls or transports, for hire or profit, any goods, wares, merchandise, baggage, products or building material of any kind from one place to another within the corporate limits of the City of Payette, ^{or from any outside point to any place within the city limits, or from any place within the city limits to any outside point} for any person or persons, firm or corporation shall for the purpose of this ordinance be deemed a drayman and doing a drayage business, and shall pay a license fee of \$750 per quarter per team ~~or~~ vehicle, or other conveyance.

Second: Every person or persons, firm or corporation who shall conduct or carry on said drayage business above mentioned without first having obtained a license and paid the fee herein provided, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined in any sum not less than two dollars, or more than one hundred dollars, or imprisonment in the City jail of not exceeding sixty days or by both such fine and imprisonment.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
