

ORDINANCE NO. 214 BY

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING TO THE BROWN LATERAL COMPANY **Ld** A CORPORATION THE RIGHT, PRIVILEGE, FRANCHISE AND AUTHORITY TO BUILD, OPERATE AND MAINTAIN WATER PIPE LINES AND WATER MAINS THROUGH THE STREETS AND ALLEYS, WITHIN A CERTAIN DISTRICT OF THE SAID CITY.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of Payette:

Section 1. That there be and hereby is granted to the Brown Lateral Company **Ld**, a corporation, and its successors and assigns, the right, privilege, authority and franchise to build, operate and maintain water pipe lines and water systems for the purpose of conveying and distributing water for irrigating purposes only, to its stockholders, on lands in said City of Payette, Idaho, lying South of Third Avenue South and East of 9th Street. **to City limit**

Section 2. All main lines and laterals of said water pipe line and water system shall be properly constructed and maintained by said Brown Lateral Company **Ld** not less than two feet under ground, and the waters therein conducted shall not be permitted or allowed to flow or in any way damage the streets, alleys or public grounds of said City.

Section 3. Said water pipe line and water system shall be so constructed as to not interfere with any other pipe, sewer, conduit or other pipe or works lawfully entitled to be in any street, or alley in that part of the said City where this authority extends to said company. The said Brown Lateral Company **Ld** shall forever save the City of Payette harmless from any damages that may be sustained by reason of the said pipes and water system being run in and along the said streets and alleys in said district or part of the said City.

Section 4. The said Brown Lateral Company **Ld** grants to the said City of Payette, the right and privilege to use whatever water may be desired to be used by it for sprinkling and fire purposes, provided

all water that is used for sprinkling purposes shall be used on streets and alleys lying South of 3rd Avenue South and East of 9th Street, which privilege shall be without compensation from the said City of Payette, but shall be considered the license fee for the use of said streets and alleys as herein provided; provided further that all ^{actual} expense for tapping water mains for stand pipes, or hydrants shall be borne by the said City of Payette.

Section 5: The location of all pipes shall be under the direction of the Mayor and Council of the said City, which shall be as near as practicable along the side of streets, near curb line.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval and publication in the official newspaper of the said City.
