ORDINANCE NO. 275 BY CROUCH

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE OPERATION OF AUTOMOBILES, OR OTHER MOTOR VEHICLES CARRYING OR TRANSPORTING PASSENGERS FROM PLACE TO PLACE FOR HIRE WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE IDAHO; PROVIDING FOR THE PAYMENT OF A LICENSE FOR THE OPERATING OF SAID BUSINESS, AND PROHIBITING THE TRANSFER OF SAID LICENSE, AND PROVIDING FOR THE PUNISHMENT FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF, AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of Payette:

Section 1. Every person, firm, association or corporation desiring to carry on or engage in the business of automobile, locomobile, taxi-cab or other motor vehicle of whatsoever kind that runs or operates by power generated on said vehicle, livery for hire, or who transports or carries persons from place to place within the corporate limits of the City of Payette, or who uses or operates any of the foregoing vehicles for the conveyance of passengers from place to place within the corporate limits of the said city, for hire, shall pay a yearly license for each and every ~~xxxx~~ vehicle in the sum of \$ 20.⁰⁰/₁₀₀ per year, payable in advance, from and after the first day of October, 1915, The number contained in said license shall be the number of the vehicle to be operated under said license.

Section 2. Every agent, owner or driver of any of the enumerated vehicles, before engaging in the business as described in section 1 of this ordinance shall obtain a license so to do as prescribed in section 1 of this ordinance, from the City Clerk of the said City, which license shall be valid only to the person to whom issued; and no license provided for in this ordinance shall be transferable or assignable, and any person, firm, association or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall forfeit the said license provided for in said section 1 hereof, and shall not receive another license to engage in said

business for the period for which said license was forfeited.

Section 3. Every owner, employee, agent or driver of any vehicle enumerated in section 1 of this ordinance, shall place the number of the vehicle as mentioned in the said license, upon each side of said vehicle or in some other conspicuous place.

Section 4. Every firm, association, corporation or person violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof in the Municipal Court of said City, shall forfeit his license, as provided for in section 2 hereof, and shall be fined in any sum not exceeding one hundred dollars, or thirty days in the City Jail or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Section 5. This ordinance shall be in force from and after its passage, approval and publication in the official newspaper, and all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.
